

Our big 'SERMON WORDS' today are in 2 Timothy 4 v 17: **'...the Lord stood with me'**

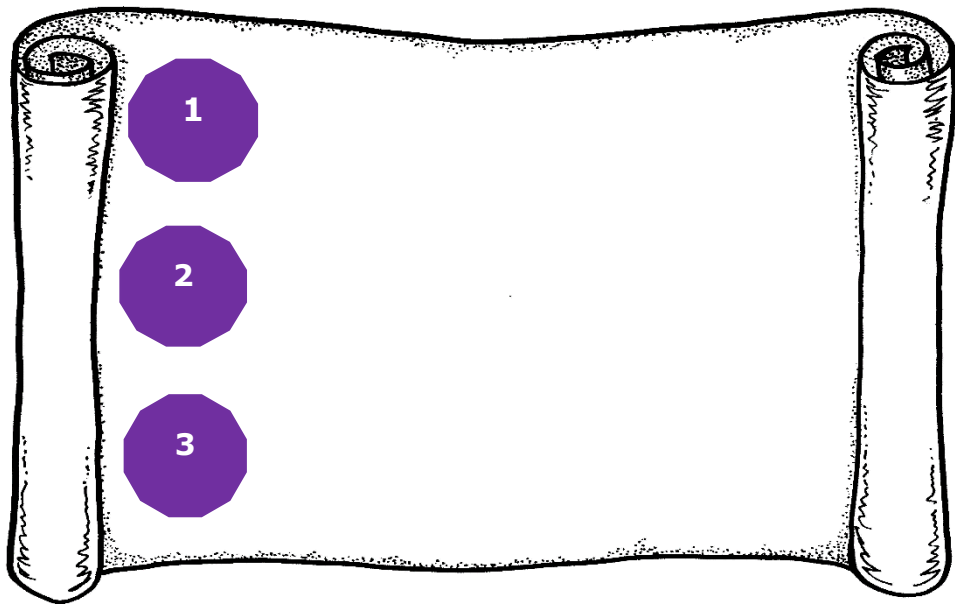
Today we are thinking about one verse in the chapter that we have read: **2 Timothy 4 v 13.**
