Acts Chapter 11 v 19 - 30

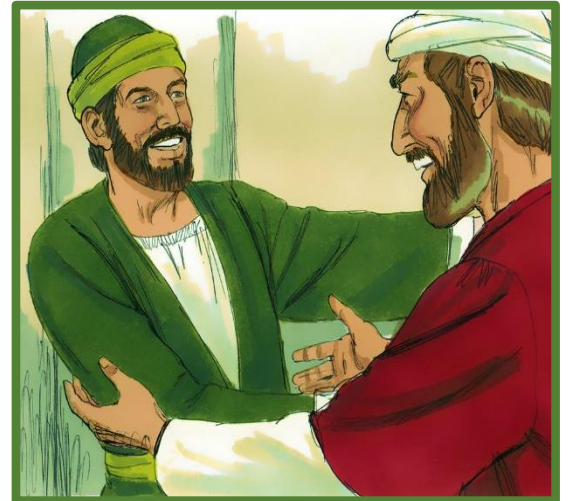
Meet Barnabas! Our **BIG SERMON WORDS** for today are **"He was a good man..."**
