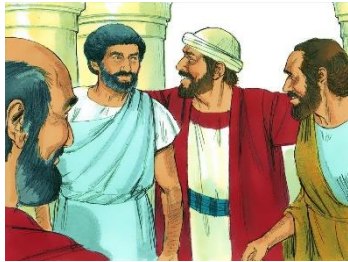


Today we set off on a missionary journey!
