What had he never been able to do? _____


God did an amazing thing for the man through Paul (14v10).

They had to explain that they were not 'gods', they were just ordinary men who had come to tell all the people about the _____ God (v15)


Even after that, more bad people came from the other cities and this time they tried to do something really horrible to Paul & Barnabas.
